Maintain consistency and parallel structure in headings and subheads. Use headline-style for purposes of capitalization.

If you're writing a paper using the Chicago Method of Style (CMOS), you would typically have both footnotes and a bibliography. A full footnote contains the same information as your bibliography entry in a slightly different format along with the page numbers where the material referenced can be found in the source.

Put endnotes after the main text and any appendixes but before the bibliography. Center the title Notes at the top of the first page and add two blank lines after.

Footnotes and endnotes require you to include detailed information about each source as you cite it. With few exceptions, you should use either footnotes or endnotes in your paper, not both.
